




MUSIC WEEK

Bendigo Instrumental Music Program



Following many years of successful music camps, the Bendigo Instrumental Music Program Staff have again organised an outstanding week of music activities, for students in years 7 to 10 currently learning instruments in Secondary Colleges around Bendigo and the region.

Music week activities provide an ideal opportunity for all students to develop their skills in a relaxed yet intensely musical environment. The program over the week will offer students experiences in a variety of ensembles.

We will have guest artists as both teachers and performers to provide a broad range of educational experiences for students.

The week will be held at **Bendigo Baptist Church, 757 McIvor Hwy** and

culminates with all students participating in a Gala Concert held on the final evening of Music Week. This concert gives students the opportunity to present and celebrate their achievements over the week.

DETAILS

Date: Monday 21st – Thursday 24th June 2021

Times: 8.45 am – 3.30 pm

Venue: Bendigo Baptist Church, 757 McIvor Hwy, Junortoun.

What to bring:

- INSTRUMENT labeled with your name
- MUSIC STAND labeled with your name. This is required by all students several times each day.
- grey lead PENCIL
- packed LUNCH, including snacks and water bottle.

Daytime Dress: Neat casual

Concert: Thursday 24th June 7.00pm at Bendigo Baptist Church Bendigo. Two tickets will be given to each student on Thursday of Music Week and entry is by gold donation. Students will need to arrive by 6.15pm or as directed by their ensemble leader.

Concert Dress: Student's choice of either Black and White performance uniform OR neat school uniform.

Students will be given more details during Music Week.

FAQ

When is Music Week 2021?

The final week of Term Two, Monday 21st – Thursday 24th June.

Does my child need to bring food?

Yes. Students are required to bring their lunch, snacks and a water bottle each day as there will be no opportunity to purchase food.

Can students go down the street to buy lunch, or order food to be delivered?

No. We are unable to supervise these activities. Please send a packed lunch with your child. Students will not be permitted to leave the venue at any stage.

Is there a bus to the camp?

No, it is not possible for us to provide transport for students or to link with the other bus networks.

Does my child wear school uniform to music week activities?

No, neat casual dress is acceptable for all daytime activities. Black and White concert uniform OR school uniform will be required for the final concert on Thursday evening.

Do I need tickets for the concert?

Tickets are \$5 and can be purchased from the Capital Theatre Bendigo or through their website.


How much will Music Week cost?

\$120 per student. We offer discounts for siblings.

Can I pay in instalments?

To ensure a place in Music Week, please pay \$50 by Friday 30th of April (the second week of Term Two) then the remaining \$70 is due by Friday the 28th of May.

PAYMENT



The attached Registration Form should be completed and returned by **Friday the 30th of April** with either the full amount, or the initial payment of \$50 per student. The remainder of the payment is due by **Friday 28^h of May**.

All Registration Forms and payments for Music Week **should be submitted to the Office at your child's school**. Please do not give forms or money to Music teachers. If paying by cheque, please make all cheques payable to your child's school.

If you are eligible for the **CSEF grant**, you may use this grant to cover the cost of the excursion. **Just write CSEF on the permission note.**

The cost of Music Week is \$120 per student, **but discounts are available where two or more students from the one family attend**. For 2 children attending the fee will be \$100 each. For 3 or more children attending the fee will be \$90 each.
